## Enter the Student Outreach program!

- Undergraduate- and graduate-level students submit article
- Judges review article
- Article published = a one-year membership in STC and the IDL SIG, courtesy of our SIG





## Enter the Student Outreach program!

- We submit their article for inclusion in Technical Communication Body of Knowledge (TCBOK)
- Article published there = another one-year membership in STC and the IDL SIG





## A win for students

Get name in front of professionals in 3 ways:

- IDL SIG newsletter
- TCBOK
- LinkedIn

#### Free introduction to professional organization

- Can develop professional acquaintances
- Can take advantage of our mentoring program once employed





## Special win for academia-bound students

Many academia jobs are now requiring publications early in the career of an instructor

- Example of job ad from University of North Texas: "A record of effective research, publication, external funding, and teaching is expected. . . "
- "Graduate students are told that publishing frequently and in traditional
  journals is key to landing a job. 'In many if not most fields it is now necessary
  to have at least one refereed journal article while still ABD,' writes Karen
  Kelsky, Vitae columnist and academic advisor for hire, on her blog."

Students could become STC and IDL SIG members upon entering the workforce





## Students who graduate before being awarded


What if a student graduates and enters employment before being awarded the membership? Does he or she forfeit the award?
