

### Q10 What is your STC membership designation?



### Q11 Why did you choose to join the IDL SIG? (select all that apply)











### Q23 Did you attend the 2016 STC Summit in Anaheim, CA?



# Q24 Which of the following IDL SIG functions did you attend at the Summit? Select all that apply.



### Q25 How did you learn of these events? Select all that apply.




